#### Description

We have a workflow whose retention delay has been configured to 7 days.  
In this workflow, a process can sometimes run for several weeks.

We noticed that for such processes, the purge deletes them as soon as they are terminated.

We presume that the purge task uses the process creation date for the retention delay, but we think it should rather be the latest date where the process has been modified.

Would it be possible to modify the purge to take into account the process last modified date instead of the creation date?
