#### Description

Hello Pierre

We found a document on which the latest PDF service is not able to write on.

You will find attached to this issue a 7zip archive containing

- the original document: assoam032014.pdf
- the document as it should be (produced using PDFTOOL): assoam032014.pdf.outpdftool.pdf
- the document as it is produced by PDF: assoam032014.pdf.out.pdf
- a procedure to reproduce the problem: add\_addressbox\_marks.pl

In fact, the PDF service writes something on the document, we can see a grey rectangle at the top left of the first page, but it is not what we expect.

Reproduced on Windows 64 and Linux 64 bits, with PDF version 2.25.
